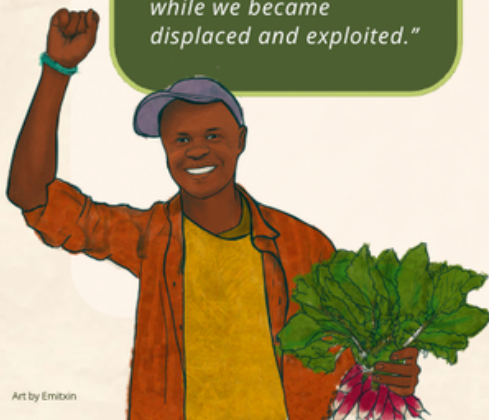


Feature Art of the Month
